



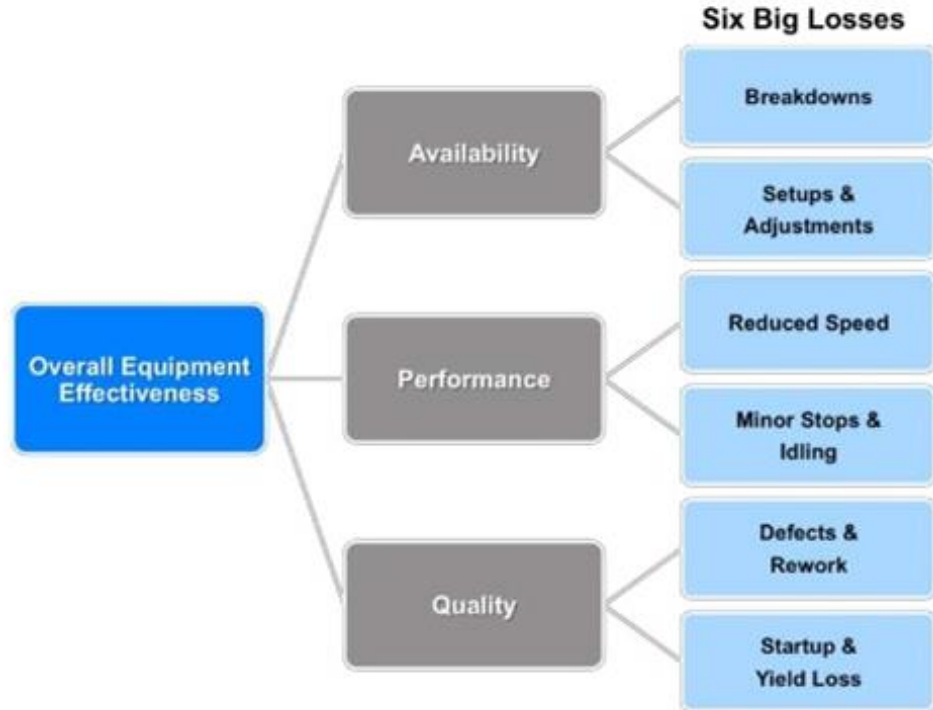

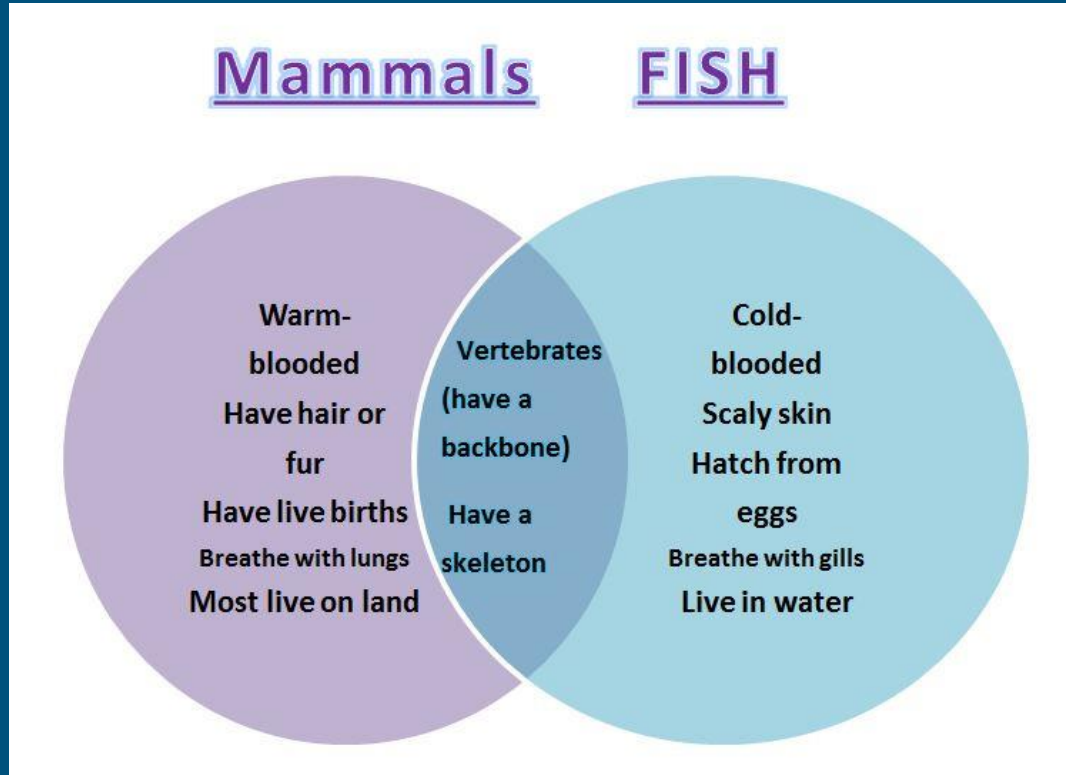

Tree diagram



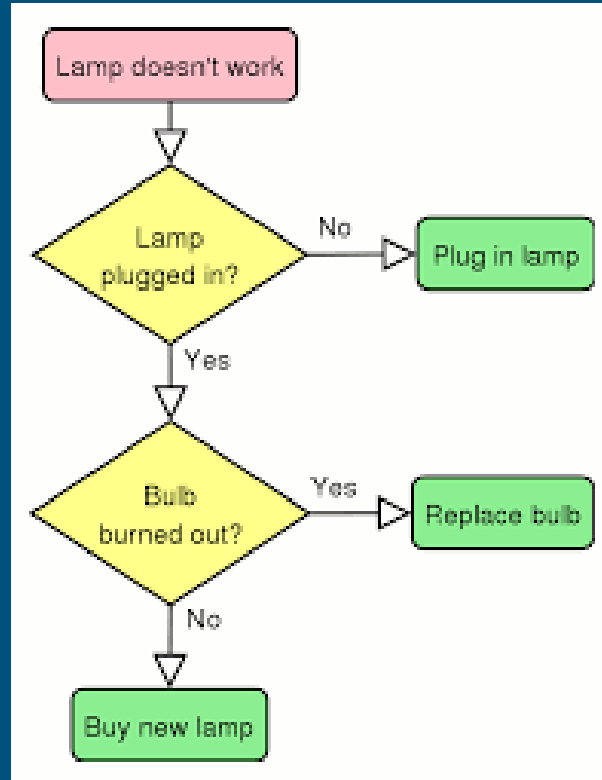
Venn diagram



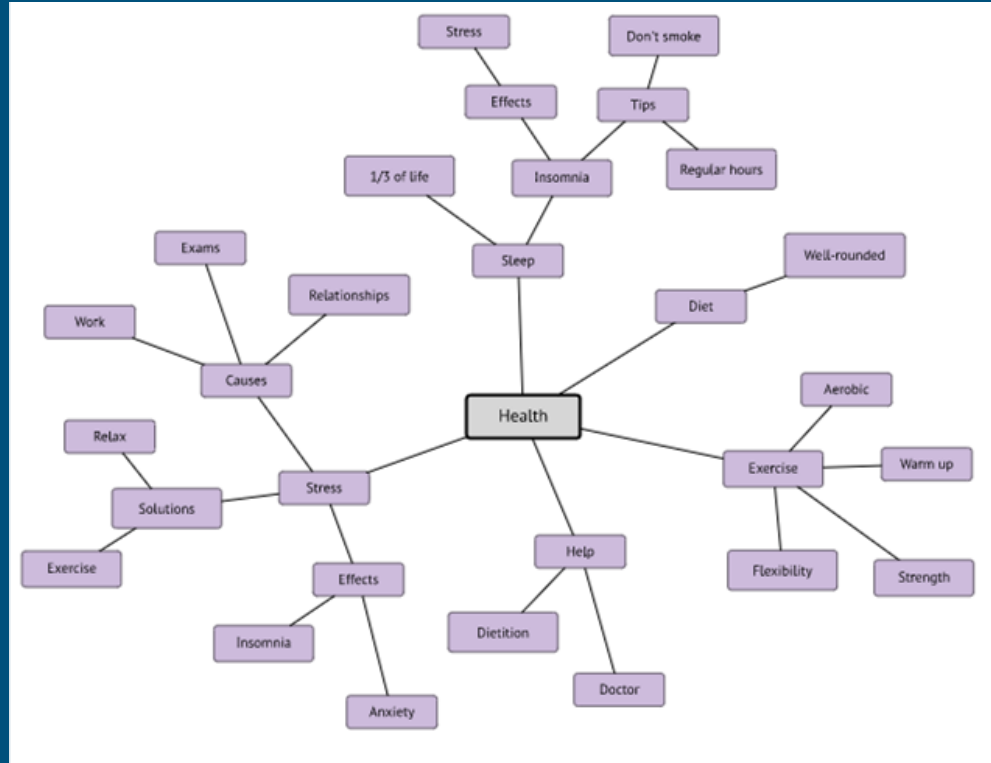


